Climate is mild with moderate precipitations. The average temperature in December is from -3 to $+3^{\circ}$ C.

Currency

Hryvna is the national Ukrainian currency. 1 US Dollar is equal to 7,95 hryvna, 1 Euro-10,5 UAH.
